## Restrictions on Shore Leave for Visiting Ships


All visiting ships are reminded that due to levels of COVID 19 infection, mainland Scotland remains in lockdown. All crew shore leave should be restricted to essential reasons only in line with Scottish Government advice.

In addition, all ship's crew on vessels bound from **Portugal** should remain onboard until their 10-day quarantine period has passed and may only step ashore to carry out essential operational tasks (such as checking draught marks).

Vessels are reminded of the requirement to submit a Maritime Declaration of Health prior to arrival as per LNTM 07/2020.
